Type of show: Juried, all media

Entry fee (non-refundable): Members \$25, Non-members \$35

Drop off work: Friday, April 26, 10 am - 4 pm
Saturday, April 27, 10 am - 1 pm *Please note change in drop off days.

Pick up work not selected: Tuesday, April 30, 10 am - 4 pm

Pick up work from exhibit: Friday, June 7, 10 am - 4 pm
Saturday, June 8, 10 am - 1 pm

Opening Reception: Thursday, May 9, 6 pm - 8 pm

Important:

A. Artists may submit up to two works. *Please note change.

B. Works must have been executed within the last two years.

C. Works previously shown at Artel may not be submitted.

D. All work must be ready for hanging or presentation and easy to exhibit with clear instructions where necessary. Artel does not provide wire. Artwork without hanging hardware will not be accepted. Hanging hardware should be sturdy wire and of good quality. Pedestals should be appropriate for the work, preferably cream or white, clean and freshly painted. Wet paintings will not be accepted. Crafts art will not be accepted for Artel shows.

E. Artists should come prepared with title, media, framed dimensions and price for each work. Download a check-in sheet from our website at artelgallery.org or pick one up at Artel Please do not make others wait by being unprepared.

F. Keep in mind Artel's mission of providing a venue for experimental contemporary art. By submitting your work to Artel shows, you are giving us permission to consider using your art on our website and in grant applications. If you do not wish your work to be used, you must inform us at drop off.

Guidance: There is a certain element of control in self portraits. Maybe there is more to you than meets the eye, but it is up to you if you'd like to share that. Take a glimpse into the mirror, literal or figurative, and demonstrate your perception of self.

Juror: Krist Lien. After completing his MFA, Krist began his college teaching career in 1992 as an adjunct in Alabama at the University of Montevallo, the University of Alabama at Birmingham, and Livingston University. In 1993, Krist was hired as the Chair of the Art Department at Livingston University, where he stayed for two years before moving to Shelton State Community College in Tuscaloosa, Alabama. Krist taught and served as Department Head for twelve years. After moving to Florida, he was hired at Pensacola State College in 2006 as the District Academic Department Head for Visual Art.
